HOLY WEEK SCHEDULE

Sunday, April 10 ~ Palm Sunday (8:00am and 10:30 am)

We gather outdoors this Sunday with palms and prayers to hear of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem at the beginning of his last week. We hear songs and shouts of hosanna as Jesus arrives, only to experience the events of what would happen later that week. Services are at 8:00am and 10:30am.

Thursday, April 14 ~ Maundy Thursday (Noon and 7:00 pm)

On this day we hear Jesus' commandment to love one another and give thanks for the sacrament of Holy Communion that he began in the Last Supper. We also take with us his example of service to others as he knelt to wash his disciples' feet. Our 12:00pm service will be a service of foot washing and communion. While the 7:00pm service will focus on Communion and end with the traditional stripping of the altar, representing Jesus as he was arrested and stripped of his robes and dignity.

Friday, April 15 ~ Good Friday (10:30 am and 7:00 pm)

On this day we remember and celebrate our Lord's life-giving passion on the cross. There are two different ways you are invited to observe this holy day: At 10:30am we are joining with other local churches for a Prayer Walk. We will meet at Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church Mechanicsburg. Following the Prayer Walk (around 11:30am) there will be an easter egg hunt for kids 2-12. Then at 7:00 pm we have our traditional Tenebrae service of Word and prayer in the sanctuary at TSLC.

Sunday, April 17 ~ Easter Sunday Breakfast – Our Easter Family Breakfast in the Fellowship Hall is back! Join us for breakfast from 8:00- 09:00 am. (See page 7 for more details.)

Sunday, April 17 ~ Easter Sunday (6:30 am and 10:30 am)

Alleluias break forth once more as we celebrate Jesus' resurrection and its promise of life for the world. Our Sunrise Service begins at 6:30 am in darkness with the lighting of the paschal candle, and comes to life with lights, hymns, and communion. Our Festival Easter Service is at 10:30 am as we continue our celebration of the resurrection of our Lord with singing and communion.
