Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Over the course of the past year most of my communications have been written with a heavy heart. I am excited to see the life and ministry that the Holy Spirit is moving us into as we come out of "pandemic mode."

## MAY 11, 2021 TSLC COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

**Covid-19 Update:** Recommendations to council from the Task Force included: Singing for indoor worship services will resume when 70% compliance is reached in Cumberland County. Masks will be voluntary for outdoor services and there will be singing. Occupancy rates for the Fellowship Hall will be raised to 75.

**Church Services:** Beginning May 23rd, the late service will move outdoors and begin at 9:30. This will enable congregational singing and be early enough to avoid the heat. In the event of inclement weather or extreme temperatures, the service will be moved indoors. The 8:00 service will still be indoors and will be live streamed.

**Pastor's Bible Study:** This is going well with lively, meaningful discussions and the option to attend via ZOOM or outdoors at Pastor's house.

**Memorials:** All members of church committees are requested to submit any items or projects that they feel would enhance their mission or for items needing repair/replacement to their committee chair. These lists will be compiled and kept by the Archive committee for reference when memorial requests are made.

# safety & security

Hello Everyone,

As we, with cautious optimism, appear to be getting closer to normal, Safety and Security has been busy. You may not have noticed but the installation of the upgraded smoke detector system has been begun. This will be beneficial to us providing greater fire safety. Previously, the only smoke detectors in the whole facility could be seen standing in one spot in the narthex. The new system has smoke detectors in all rooms, along with horn/strobe alarms in all rooms.

Additionally, we are having the new access system installed. The list of key holders for the Church has gotten to the point we do not have an accurate accounting of where all the keys have gone. So, we are installing a system that will give us a fresh start. Outside door locks will be changing. Instead of a metal key the three main entrances will be unlocked using a smartphone. Or, if you don't have a smartphone we can issue you a proximity card. Both of these will be set up on the computer so with a few keystrokes, if a member loses their card or phone we deny access to that card or phone. It will allow for temporary access to be granted to outside groups. That ends when they no longer require access. All through a computer, so the access can be tracked.

As soon as the new access system is up and running, and we have received the training on the system, we can begin granting access. We will be asking those who need access to submit the required information to us.

You'll notice new signs going up in our parking lot informing people that our parking lot is private property. The parking lot is intended for use by church members or for those attending church functions only.

CPR Training- Watch for announcements regarding upcoming training dates. Beginning in June, the American Heart Association will be allowing in-person training. We will be scheduling some dates in the near future.


