Friends in Christ,

We trust that the Holy Spirit will work in our midst to bring a new staff member into our midst.

ACCESS TO THE CHURCH BUILDING ~ *UPDATE* FROM DENNIS STONER SAFETY & SECURITY TEAM

I pray this finds you happy, healthy, and safe. We have had some changes made to our access system, nothing that most of you will even notice. There are some operational changes related to unlocking doors or relocking doors on Sunday mornings. The double entrance doors should now both be unlocked and relocked via the access system. Please do not use Hex Keys to lock or unlock doors. We are adding some additional doors to the access system. If it has not yet occurred, in the near future both the exterior kitchen door and exterior choir door will be added to the access system. If you currently use your church key to unlock either of those doors, you will need to contact Dennis Stoner or Chuck Sterling to be issued a Brivo Pass on your Smartphone or a Proximity Key Card. Your key will no longer work once the access system is installed on those doors.

The weather is getting warmer, and kids will be out of school in the next few days. We would like to remind you to be more careful while driving. It's easy to miss seeing bicyclists or motorcyclists when you are driving around on the roads. You pull up to a stop sign, traffic is heavy so you're looking for that break in the traffic. You look both ways thinking you found the perfect spot to pull out and look 1 more time only to see a motorcycle or bicyclist coming towards you. They aren't the visual target we see easily- a bike riding along the edge of the road or a motorcycle hidden by a car ahead of it are not easy to spot. Take the time to look again before pulling into traffic. Like I said, school will be out in a few days, expect more kids to be out running around and biking, more things to watch for while driving. As the patches worn by some motorcyclists say, "Look Twice Save a Life".
