Friends in Christ,

I am sitting down to write to you today after having done another hospital visit. I am acutely aware that right now there are so many families who are dealing with major health issues or who have loved ones currently experiencing major health issues. There has been an increase in Covid cases in the congregation, which we have not seen in some time, and there are many experiencing challenging diagnoses or undergoing surgeries that require support and recovery. I know that this isn't unusual or out of the ordinary. However, lately these visits and calls have been a strong reminder to me for the need for a community of care and support.

Covid created some disconnects within relationships. On a Sunday morning it was always good to see church friends and spend time together in worship and in conversations before and after the service. There are those who we have not seen often, but they are still important members of the congregation. WE NEED EACH OTHER. I think that is one thing that we as Christians have always known, but Covid reminded us of.

So, today as I write to you, I want to encourage you to do something. Take a half hour out of your week and reach out to someone. Whether it is their birthday, you know they've been ill, maybe they've lost a loved one, or you just happen to think about them. Make it a priority to reach out in an act of Christian love. We need each other, and we all need to know that others care about us.

When we read through the Gospels we hear many stories of Jesus turning to see a large crowd of people looking for him, looking for him to provide food, looking for healing, looking for many things, and he is moved with compassion. There are certainly moments in our lives when we are reminded that life is fragile, and we need the support of a loving community of faith to be at our best. One of our calls as Christians is to show the love and compassion of God to others

So, my invitation to you is to be that beautiful, wonderful, caring Christian community that I have known you to be. Don't hesitate to reach out and say, "I've missed you," or "It's been too long, we should get together." Don't wait for someone else to do it. Reach out to someone in the same way you would want others to reach out to you. (Matthew 7:12)






