
We have some vital dates quickly approaching as we kick off our 2022-23 program year. Please mark your calendars now!


BLESSING OF THE ANIMALS

OUTREACH NEWS – FRIENDS OVER FENCES MINISTRY

Do you know someone who enjoys getting a card or a note on a rainy day, at a lonely time, or when they are feeling really down? Can you imagine the smile on their face when they realize that someone cares and is reaching out to connect with them, showing that God's love can come in an envelope?

"Lord, when did we see you...in prison and not minister to you?" Matthew 25:44

Friends Over Fences is a local organization that reaches out to inmates and ex-offenders to help bring God's message of love and forgiveness to them while they are in prison and to help them successfully re-enter society with the emotional support and material things that they need to become successful after their release from prison.

Although this organization welcomes any monetary donations and the donation of household needs, clothes, and other items, Friends Over Fences is asking our church for volunteers to write letters to someone in prison. After filling out the form below, John Langel, the Pen Pal Coordinator, will match you with an inmate who has requested a Pen Pal. If you decide that it is a good match, you begin writing letters within the guidelines that are offered by the organization. The time commitment can be as little or as long as you are able. As a former Pen Pal, some letters were just short notes or postcards, and others were lengthy letters. Men write to men; women write to women. You are welcome to use the church address to write letters through, if you do not feel comfortable using your home address. There will be a church mailbox listed for FOF where you can check for any mail that comes in for you.

The fact remains - they are human beings. Loneliness is one of the greatest challenges they face each day. Mail call may be the lowest point of their day, yet communication is essential in the rehabilitation process. Studies have shown that those inmates who have folks on the outside taking an interest in them have a much lower recidivism rate than those who do not. So, thank you for this selfless act which is more than the price of a stamp.
